**lyun:** Interactive shiurim and chavrusa learning guide students as they delve deeply to gain clarity and a profound understanding of the gemara. Critical thinking skills are developed through this process of in-depth learning.

**Bekiyus:** Shiurim and chavrusa learning expose talmidim to a breadth of gemara learning at a faster pace while developing reading skills to make a leining.

**Halacha:** Talmidim study mishna berura with the goal of amassing knowledge in practical halacha for everyday life. Bochurim learn how to independently learn and understand the halacha from the study of the text.

Daily mussar study through shiurim and chavrusa learning focuses on the study of the classic mussar sefarim and their applications.

Additionally, a weekly shmuess and chazaras hashmuess assist talmidim in developing analytical skills by delving into mussar lessons gleaned from select ma'marei chazal.

Mussar vaadim focus on practical application and guidance through delving into mussar subjects. Guest speakers share their knowledge with talmidim on important topics.


**MAGNIFICENT CAMPUS**
